ACCEPTANCE OF NBEO AMENDMENT POLICY

The National Board of Examiners in Optometry (NBEO) School Policy established since 2008 has been amended to require the approval of part I (ABS), as a requisite to complete the degree of Doctor of Optometry, instead of requiring it for enrollment in the second semester of the 4th year program.

This amendment also implies that any student that does not receive the Doctor of Optometry degree can't participate in the graduation ceremony of his corresponding year.

ORIGINAL POLICY

Is published on the School Catalog since 2008 for the classes of 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015.

Students at Inter American University of Puerto Rico School of Optometry will be required to pass Part I of the National Board of Examiners in Optometry examination before enrolling into the second semester of the last year of the School's Professional Degree Program.

AMENDED POLICY

Will be published in the current School Catalog and applied to the classes of 2012, 2013, 2014, 2015 and subsequent.

Students at Inter American University of Puerto Rico School of Optometry will be required to pass the Applied Basic Science Examination (ABS) of the National Board of Examiners in Optometry as a requisite to complete the degree of Doctor of Optometry.
