


Choose Apple > System Preferences, and then click Network. Select the network connection from the list, and then click Advanced.



Click TCP/IP, and then use the Configure IPv4 pop-up menu to make the following adjustments:

- DHCP must be set to “automatic”
- DHCP Client ID - you must write here your student ID. It **MUST** be filled, otherwise your Mac will **NOT** connect anywhere thru the Optometry School LAN.
- An IP Address starting with "169." is **not** a valid IP address on the LAN - it's self-assigned, and means there is a problem.
- This change is required, due to changes in Apple's Software Security, not in the Optometry School LAN configuration.

NOTE: After you have configured the Ethernet settings, select AirPort. Verify the AirPort (at least for the WIFIOPTO network) is configured the same way as the Ethernet settings.
