

Off Campus Housing

Bedroom

- ☐ Bedding (Sheets, comforter-optional, but it is very warm here & we never use one)
- ☐ Pillows
- ☐ Plastic drawers or dresser
- ☐ Curtains/blinds optional depending on apartment (they may already be there)
- ☐ Hangers
- ☐ Desk
- ☐ Bookcase

Bathroom

- ☐ Toiletries
- ☐ Towels
- ☐ Shower curtain
- ☐ Bath accessories if needed/wanted (soap dish, toothbrush holder, etc.)
- ☐ Bath mats/rugs
- ☐ Toilet paper

Kitchen

- ☐ Table & chairs
- ☐ Utensils & silverware
- ☐ Pots & pans
- ☐ Dishes & drink ware
- ☐ Storage containers
- ☐ Toaster

Kitchen (continued)

- ☐ Microwave if not included
- ☐ Other optional gadgets (blender, mixer, coffee pot, sandwich maker, crock-pot, etc.)
- ☐ Trash bags/sandwich bags/storage bags
- ☐ Paper towels/napkins
- ☐ Dish rack/drying rack

Living Room

- ☐ Furniture of choice
- ☐ TV
- ☐ Lamps
- ☐ Gaming consoles/DVD player-remember appropriate cords & remotes (DVD's)

Miscellaneous

- ☐ Cleaning supplies (mops, brooms & dustpan, vacuum, but almost everything is tile so it depends on apartment)
- ☐ Chargers (phone, iPod, Kindle, Computer, etc.)
- ☐ Batteries
- ☐ Decorations (pictures, signs)
- ☐ Games/cards
- ☐ School supplies (backpack, notebooks, pens, papers, notecards, highlighters, flash drives)
- ☐ Flashlights & candles
- ☐ Stationary (notes & cards, stamps)
- ☐ Umbrella
- ☐ Beach equipment (towels, bags, sunscreen, sunglasses, hats, cooler, chairs)
- ☐ Inflatable air mattress

Miscellaneous (continued)

- ☐ Rugs
- ☐ Lunch bag
- ☐ Books/magazines you enjoy reading in your free time
- ☐ Surge protector

I am not aware of any 1 bedroom apartments, most are 2 or 3 bedrooms. Also, be prepared to pay a deposit as well as 1st month's rent. Again, those prices vary depending on apartment and owner. Utilities (electric & water) will require a deposit as well. Cable is optional and is through OneLink or DIRECTV.
