- 6. Study Rooms can be used without limit of time until another group makes a request.
- 7. While using a room, the person or group is responsible for:
  - ✓ maintaining the room clean
  - ✓ keeping the light on while using the room
  - ✓ maintaining a considerate level of noise at all time
  - ✓ cleaning the boards and for turning off the light when leaving
  - ✓ to notify the librarian in charge when a room is not in use and picking up your ID at the front desk when leaving

  - ✓ any activity that disrupt the study and work environment
  - ✓ storage (we are not responsible for any properties left unattended)
  - leave cell phones or computers charging while the group is not at the room
