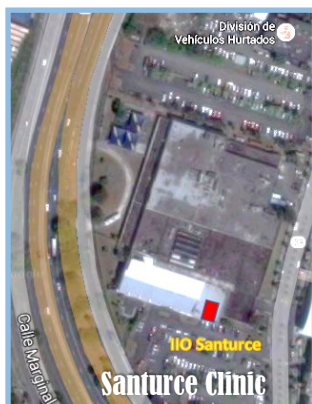

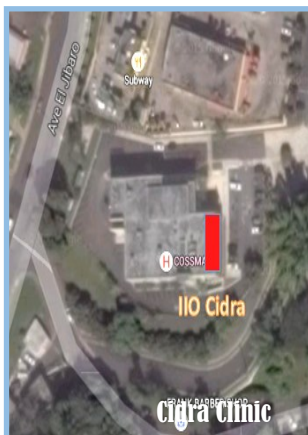

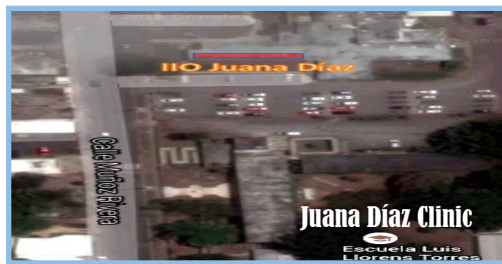

Tips FOR Prevention

1. Do not stay alone in a classroom, use the library.
2. Travel with a friend or in a group.
3. Be alert and aware of surroundings.
4. Do not carry excess amounts of cash or more credit cards than you need.
5. Have your vehicle keys in hand when you approach your vehicle.
6. Immediately lock all doors upon entering your vehicle or exiting vehicle.
7. Use well lighted streets to reach your destination.
8. If you feel you are being followed, go to the nearest store or occupied building to request assistance.
9. Do not enter elevator if you are uncertain of any occupant.
10. Be aware of emergency exits.
11. Do not leave your wallet/purse or other valuables unattended.
12. Never give out personal information over the phone, such as social security number, date of birth, credit card number or bank PIN code, unless you initiated the phone call or know exactly who you are dealing with.
13. **Your life is more important than anything material value.**

How to report an emergency?

Identify the risks

- Emotional crisis:
→ Contact the Dean of Students Affairs or the Counselor.
- If the situation involves violence, weapons, aggressions, drugs or alcohol
→ Call the Bayamon Security Guards.
- If the intervention of the authorities is needed.
